





Funding Opportunities

Design Your Own Summer Internship Program (DYO)

- FWS students only
- Salary paid by Cornell for full-time positions with non-profits (75%) and small businesses (50%)
- Earn up to \$3,750!!!



Additional Funding Opportunities

- Janet McKinley '74 Family Grant
 - Sophomores only
 - "interesting, provocative, and entrepreneurial summer projects"
 - Deadline is very soon!!
- Summer Experience Grant
 - https://as.cornell.edu/careers/summer-experience-grant-funding
 - Have an offer for a career-related summer experience that is 1) unpaid or minimally paid* and 2)
 at least 4 weeks in length, working at least 15 hours/week. The offer does NOT yet need to be
 accepted.

Human Ecology Summer Research Stipend

 The College of Human Ecology provides 16 \$5,000 stipends to CHE undergraduates who will be involved in full-time summer research with a CHE faculty member. Both the student and the faculty member must be in CHE

Alumni-Sponsored Internship Funding

 The Human Ecology Internship Funding is designed to aid students' participation in unpaid or minimally paid career-related summer experiences.

- Do not have to be Cornell professors also consider research at your home institution






